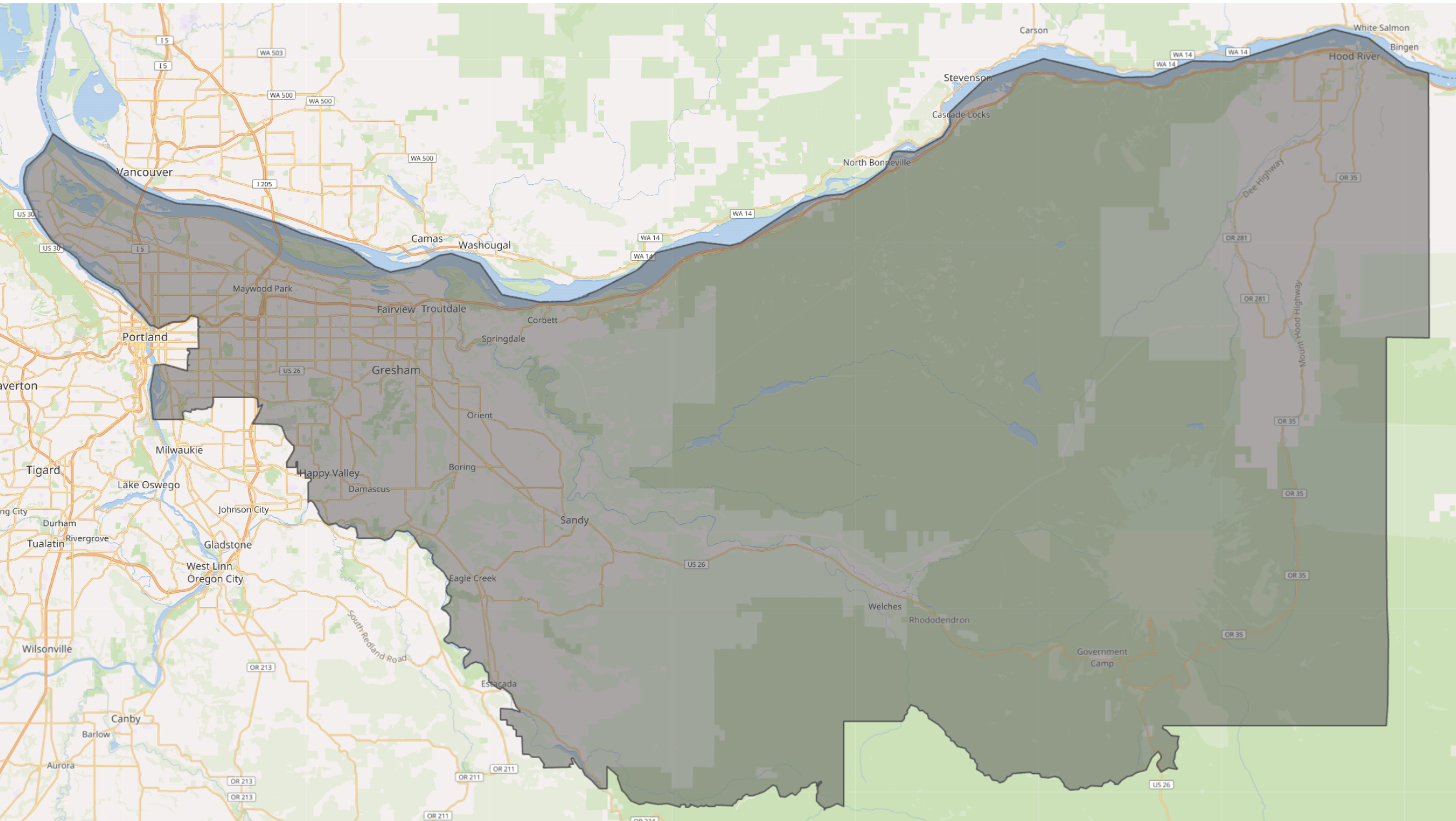


HOW BIG IS THE 3RD CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT?
