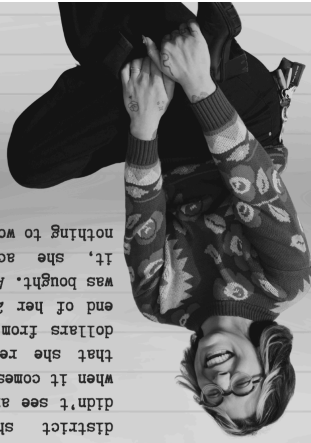

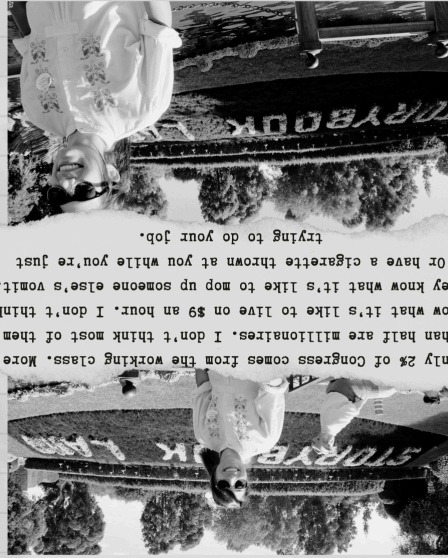


THAT'S WHEN I DECIDED TO RUN
